Anne’s work in schools has identified the need for strategic early intervention and long term therapy for children with all levels of hearing loss in order for them to reach their potential. She believes that early learning follows natural child development stages, and listening and speaking are vital in this process. The education system of NSW is a highly aural and verbal environment with critical learning occurring at all times in a day. Children with all levels of hearing loss need support to access the learning the other children take for granted.
